In any retail environment theft and pilfering from the cash register is a potential risk and a drain on profits, whether it is a shop, pub, club or Petrol Station....

VSI-PRO Cash Register Interface is easily installed into any new or existing CCTV system. It can help detect cash register / EPOS system theft and fraud by displaying transaction text details and alarm events on the CCTV picture.

Spot the Difference



The picture on the right clearly shows the staff member fraudulently scanning the confectionery barcode so the bottle of whisky that goes over the counter is uncharged, this is easily picked up by the VSI-PRO as indicated by the text on screen.



The picture on the right shows without doubt that not all items passed over the counter were entered into the cash register. Shown are just two examples of how the VSI-PRO will dramatically cut theft and fraud at the point of sale.

Pubs, clubs, newsagents, petrol stations, supermarkets and any retail outlet can benefit from the VSI-PRO

The VSI-PRO can be covertly or overtly installed to allow the user to record such events as; "sweet hearting", voids, no sale, returns & refunds, short changing and substitute scanning

Sweet Hearting

This requires an accomplice or "sweet heart" who loads up expensive items for check out. The clerk then rings up the items but charges a lower price than marked. This type of loss shows up later as shrinkage.

Voids

These can be used after the customer has left and the same transaction has been rendered void by the clerk. The money is still in the register and will have to be removed either then or towards the end of a shift.

No Sales

These are the most common suspect sale. There are legitimate uses like correcting change mistakes but if the clerk is performing "sweet hearting", pilfering, void transactions or substitute scanning, towards the end of a shift they will have to remove the accumulated money before their shift ends. Therefore it is especially important to check for all no sale transactions within the last hour of a shift.

Returns/Refunds

These are usually questionable when no exchange is made and cash is being paid out. Items are pulled from stock and fictitious refunds are given to friends relatives or the clerk themselves.

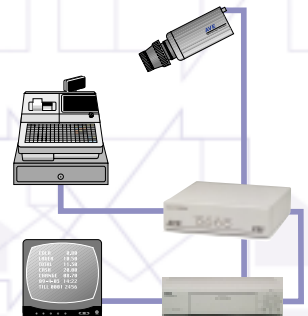
